WHERE DOES THE INSECT LIVE?

WHAT MAKES A DRAWING SCIENTIFIC?

The drawing focuses on being realistic and closely matching the details and colors of the specimen.

Look at a live insect or a photograph of the insect. Use a magnifier to **LOOK** at every detail.

Using a pencil, draw the side view or top view of the insect.

LOOK—DRAW—LOOK—DRAW.

Draw only what you see. The accurate size is important. This is a scientific drawing.

Don't add a smile to its face. Use colored pencils to fill in the realistic colors.
